Welcome to GemArts' Autumn / Winter 2012 Season.

What a brilliant summer we've had, as well as GemArts bringing you a packed programme of performances and festivals we've had an amazing time supporting and celebrating the Queen's Diamond Jubilee, the Cultural Olympiad, Olympics and Paralympics – wow!

Okay, weather wise, it has been a typical British summer with more rain than sun, but here at GemArts we promise you an extended Indian summer as our September programme begins at The Sage Gateshead with two outstanding international musicians, Murad Ali on sarangi, and Grammy nominated, Ustad Shujaat Khan on sitar.

As the autumn nights draw in, we present a selection of beautiful evening ragas performed by leading classical vocalists from India, including the exceptional Sanjeev Abhyankar in October, and brothers Rajan and Sajan Misra in November.

November also marks two fantastic annual events; at the beginning of the month, we host our South Asian Dance Celebration at Dance City, which brings together community groups and professionals from across the North East as they perform and celebrate the richness of the regions' South Asian Dance styles; and later that month, Diwali, the festival of lights, with incredible performances by regional artists and musicians and delicious mouth watering food.

Our final concert in December is new work co-commissioned by GemArts. Svara-Kanti led by guitar virtuoso Simon Thacker, brings together four leading performers in Indian classical, contemporary Asian and Western classical music to combine two of the world's greatest and most diverse musical cultures.

Ustad Shujaat Khan is among the top ranking North Indian classical musicians of his generation and for the first time will perform in the North East. This dexterous performer has packed in audiences at some of the world's leading venues and is particularly known for his unique interpretation of Sufi music which provides nuance, history and colour to his music. Son of the late legendary sitarist Ustad Vilayat Khan, Shujaat learnt his craft from his father and represents a new direction for sitar music. He has collaborated with exceptional artists including Bollywood legend Asha Bhosle, ace Hindustani vocalist Rashid Khan and jazz saxophonist Tim Ries among many others.

Accompanying Shujaat on tabla will be Shahbaz Hussain, an extremely versatile player who is fast emerging as one of the most promising tabla virtuosos of his generation.

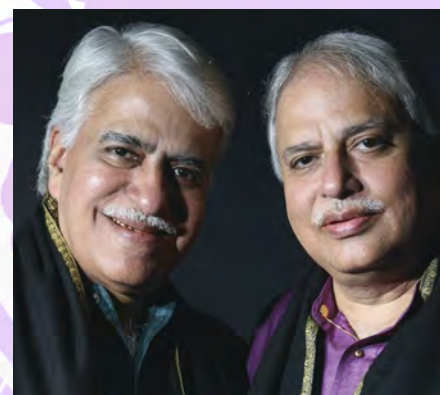

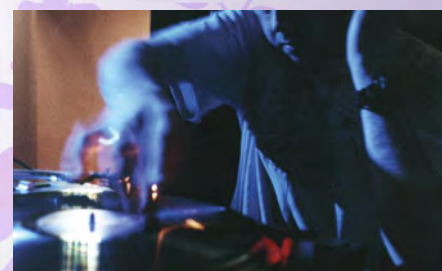
